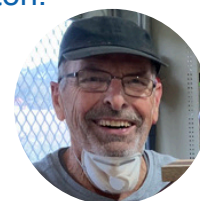
The shirts, as well as the hats are always available from Total Work Wear (which is in Lincoln Park, near the pool).



### RAFFLE WINNERS

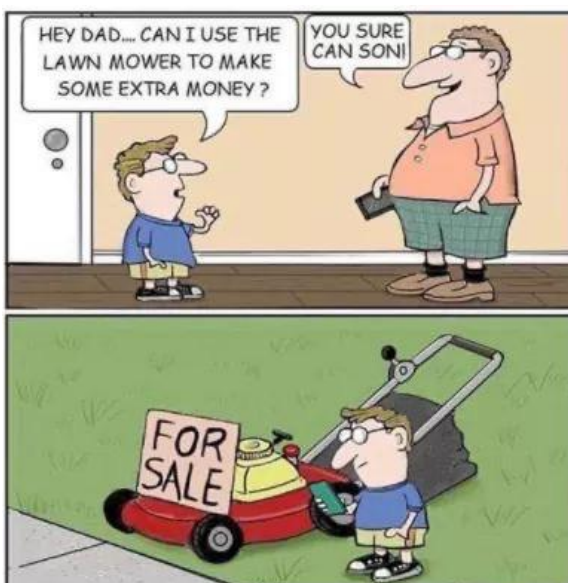
There was a huge meat tray Raffle on Friday the 24th Feb. worth in excess of \$50, and the lucky winner was: Geoff Kempton.
