Adare church council has appointed Lisa Jarvis to the position of Footloose playgroup Coordinator.

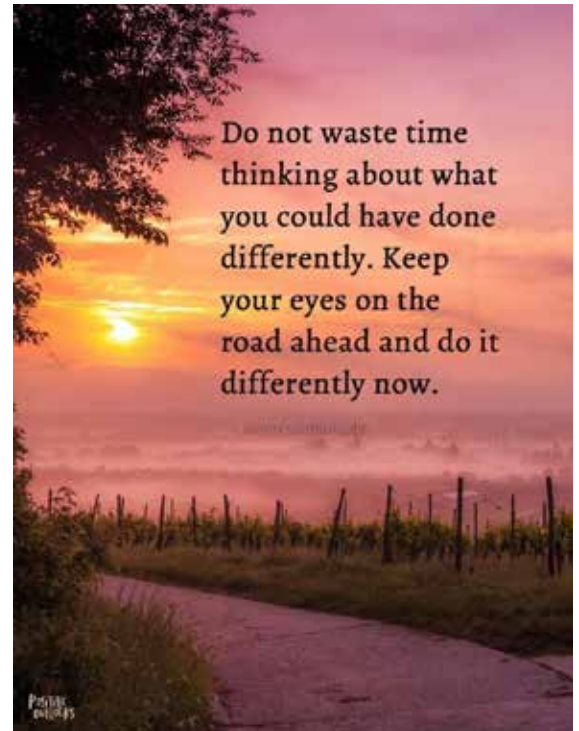
