At 5pm on Saturday 14 September the Choir of Pilgrim Church, Adelaide, will be singing evensong in Newland-Port Elliot Uniting Church (at the Victoria Street Roundabout in Victor Harbor.)

The service setting will be the Magnificat and Nunc Dimittis in D by Herbert Brewer (1865-1928) and the anthem will be the Evening Hymn by Henry Balfour Gardiner (1877-1950), some of the Choir's all-time favourites.

Evensong is a service with a beautiful and ancient liturgy, that is rich in music, inviting its participants to reflect and recharge their spiritual batteries at the closing of the day. The Choir of Pilgrim Church has been singing evensong each month for many years now and has been well received English cathedrals on its two tours of the UK in recent years.
