## CONGREGATION MEETING

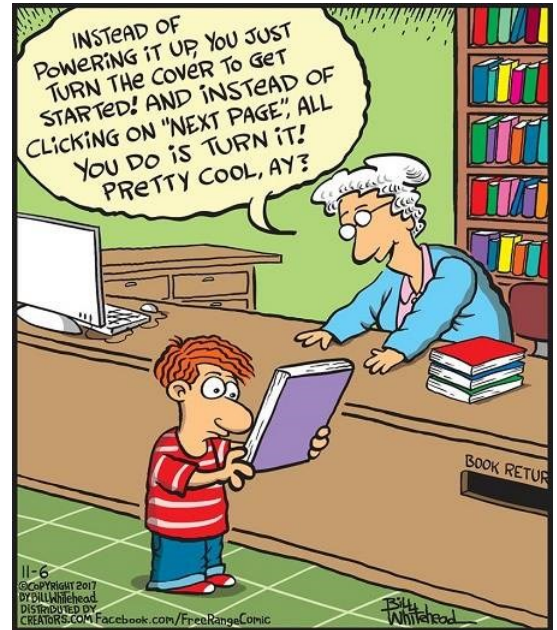
The Adare Congregation AGM will be held on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> December after our Church Service.
