Tinned fruit, coffee and tea bags, sugar

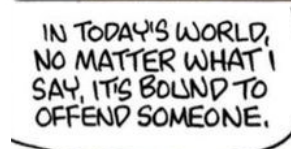
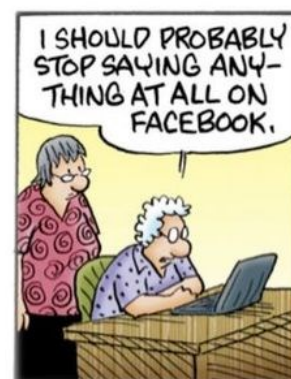
Biscuits, snack food for children
