Alan Tasker has convened the first Working Group, to decide on the make up of the pergola outside area. Have a chat to Alan or one of the group, to find out what they've thought about.





A good rollup for the AGM. A few changes were made, some reported earlier, but check out the minutes of the meeting for details.




