Bruce Trigg is having a few ongoing health issues, and Gunnar and Volker have both had surgery recently. All the best, fellas!

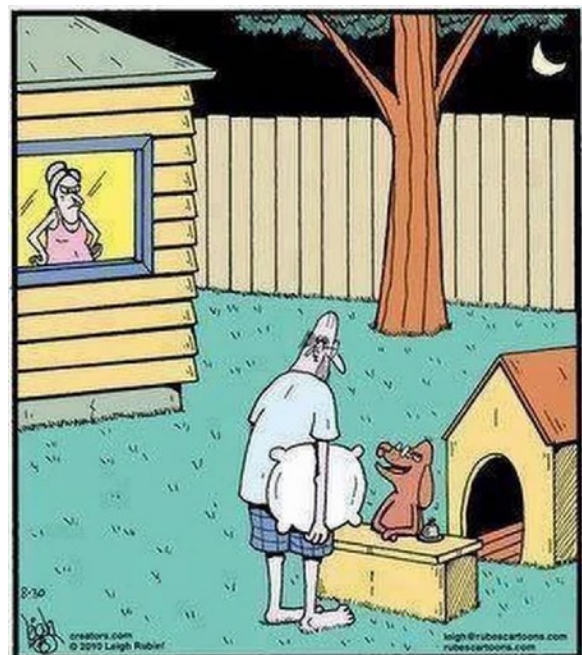
We have a **metalwork lathe for sale** - see Greg or Dean for details.

Great to see Ken Duggan back in action, with a bit of "zip" in his step.



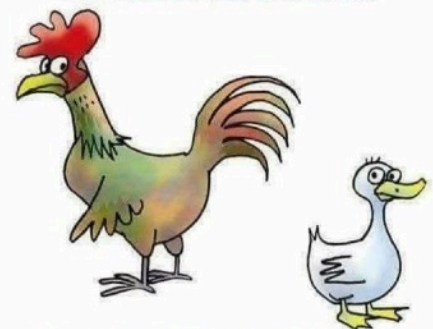
Jeff Simpson with his assistance dog Ava, who's keeping an eye on Jeff's every move.

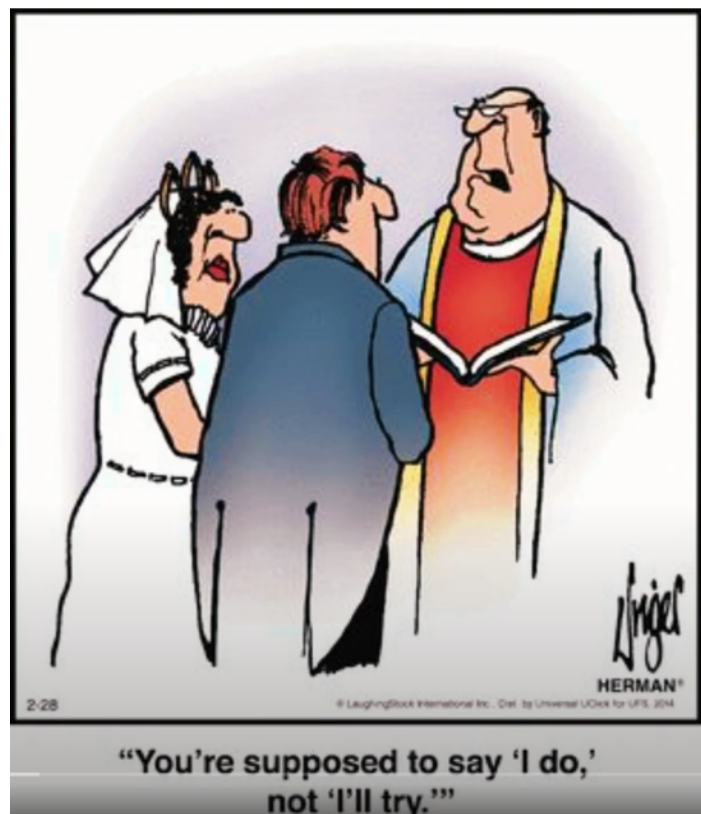
