This is a reminder that on the first Sunday of each month food and cash donations are gratefully received. Just place your donated foods in the box in the church foyer, next to the rectangular table.

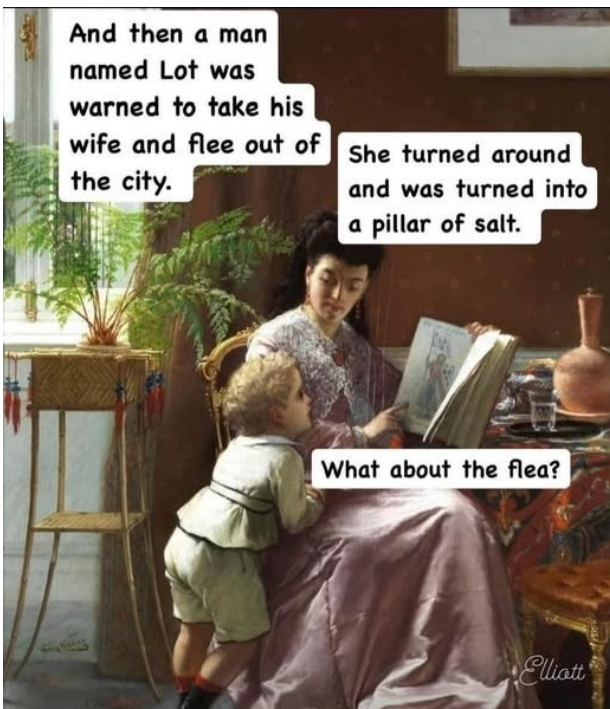
