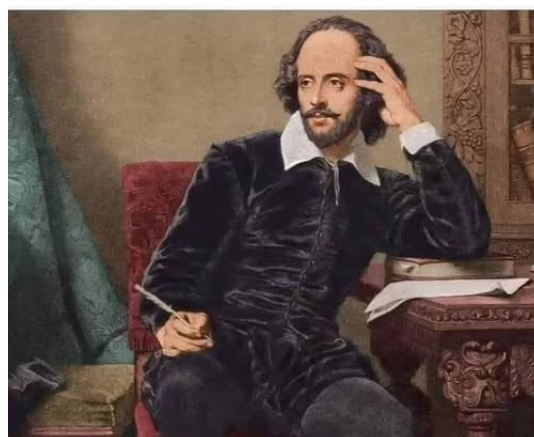
We raised \$510 for Frontier Services.

On **22 June 2025**, the Uniting Church congregations in Victor Harbor will celebrate the UCA's 48th anniversary with a joint service, this year to be held at Yilki Uniting Church, Giles Street, Encounter Bay, at 10 am, followed by lunch at 12 noon.

Arrangements for the service:

Offerings will be collected at the door on entry, with different receptacles marked with the names of the different congregations. Please place your offering in the appropriate receptacle.

- Hymn books (normal and large print) will be available at the door for those who prefer this. The words will also be visible on the screen in the front of the church.
- Limited parking space is available at the back of the church building. Please make this available to the less mobile. Paul Green will be on hand to assist.

Further parking is available in surrounding streets, and a number of off-street parking bays have recently been created. For the slightly more mobile, there is a fair amount of parking off-street along Franklin Parade, within walking distance. Please consider car-pooling as much as possible, and drop passengers off at the door if you have to park further away.

Arrangements for the lunch:

From 12 noon, at the Grosvenor Hotel in Ocean Street. Parking is available at the back of the hotel off Railway Terrace, in Ocean Street and in the large parking lots in McKinlay Street (behind Australia Post).

Two courses – mains and dessert, cost \$25–27 pp (TBC) payable at the Hotel. This does not include drinks (alcoholic or not), coffee and tea.
