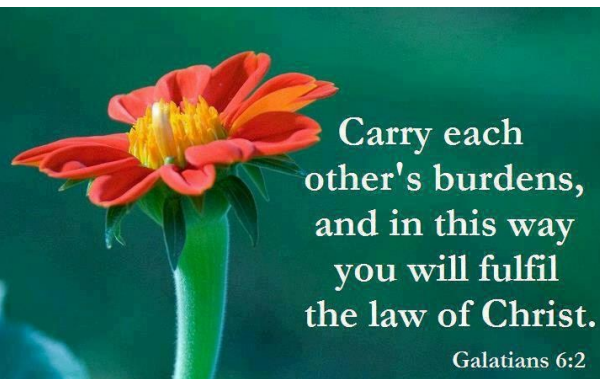

Bric-a-brac, Hardware, Craft, Paintings & CDs/DVDs – The Grove Op Shop in Adelaide.

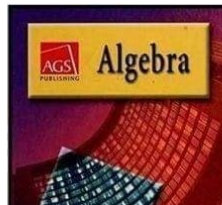
Elaine Bailey took a number of items for The Olive Tree Op Shop on Waterport Road.

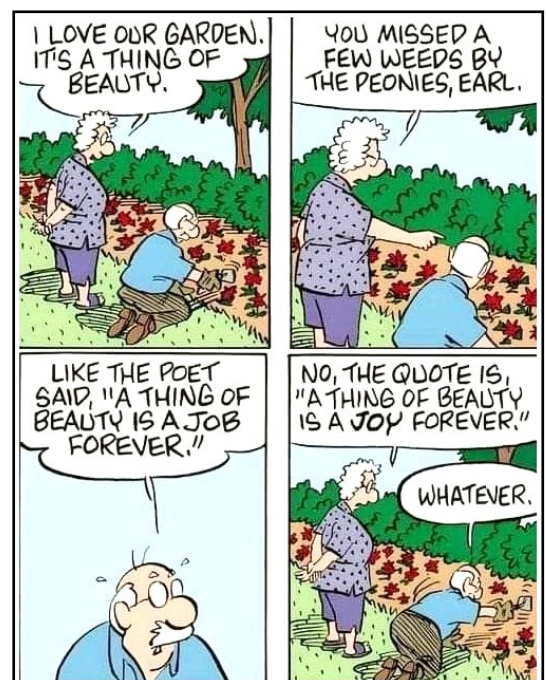
