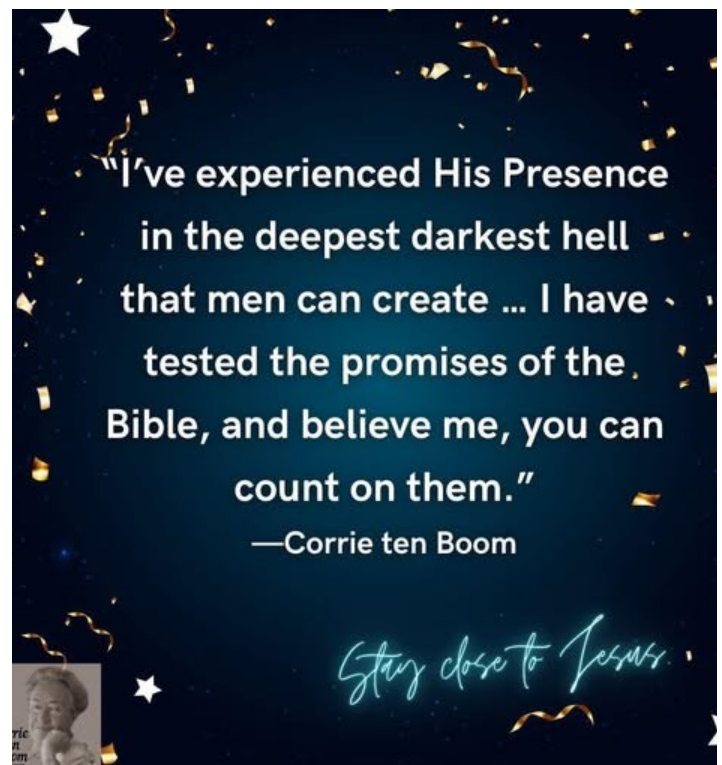
Holy Week Services
