During this difficult time, your prayers for comfort, peace and strength for Linda, Sven and their loved ones would mean so much.

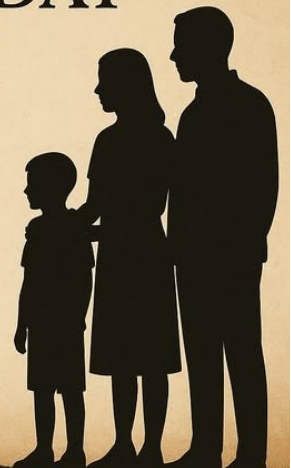
